The next Copa Maya, the competition being organised directly by GL events for the first time, will be held in the context of Mexipan.

Mexipan is the leading bakery and pastry exhibition in Mexico, and will bring together 200 exhibitors and 30,000 visitors **from 27 to 30 August 2014 at Mexico City's World Trade Centre**. For the first time at this show, a 650 m² competition area will be built to accommodate the final round of the continental selection process for the Coupe du Monde de la Pâtisserie.

The Copa Maya: Latin American selection event for the Coupe du Monde de la Pâtisserie

The Copa Maya is an integral part of the selection process for the Coupe du Monde de la Pâtisserie. Contestants representing 8 Latin American countries will be competing, and the best 3 teams will join the 19 countries already selected for the final, which will take place in Lyon in January 2015 in the context of Sirha.

Gabriel Paillason, President of the Club de la Coupe du Monde de la Pâtisserie and founder of the competition, will chair the jury made up of some of Latin America's most prestigious pastry chefs.
